Nix Grays With This Technique

Face-framing silver strands took the spring out of the Unbreakable Kimmy Schmidt star's spirals in 2015, adding decades to her look. "Since gray strands are extremely compact, it's hard for them to take color," says celebrity colorist James Corbett. His trick to hair that looks as youthful as Carol's now: Pre-soften wiry grays *before* coloring. The 20 percent peroxide in a developer cream breaks opens the hair's cuticle, allowing it to accept pigment. To do: Simply apply to damp hair and let sit for 20 minutes, then rinse and dry hair before applying color.







Erase Crow's-Feet With Peptides

She may play Superman's mom on the silver screen, but Diane's ability to age in reverse has us wondering if she's got her own superpowers. Beverly Hills-based celebrity dermatologist <u>Ava Shamban, M.D.</u>, suggests another reading: She may have switched to an eye cream infused with peptides to fade etched-in lines. "The potent amino acid compound activates cellular functions that increase collagen and elastin production to repair creases and firm skin." It's actually as effective as retinol without the irritation. Use twice a day for line-free skin in under 3 weeks.
