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Nudestix Skin Pencil, \$24 each

If you haven't tried Nudestix's collection of easy-to-use makeup crayons, get on it. This particular stick is my personal favorite, and it's available in four iterations: The Moisture Pencil with Amazonian clay mimics a lipid-rich barrier, the Matte + Blemish Pencil absorbs sebum and oils to mattify, the Clean-Up pencil helps you fix makeup mistakes, and the Blur pencil minimizes the look of lines, creases + pores for a smoother-looking texture.
