

10 Halloween Looks You Can Create With Makeup You Already Have

Make an impression without a lot of effort (or money!).

When planning a full-out Halloween costume feels like too much work, let makeup come to your rescue. There's no need to buy anything either. All of these looks can be done with products you probably already have in your makeup bag. Start each with a clean, moisturized face and finish with a spritz of setting spray to ensure your look lasts all night.

9. SCARECROW MAKEUP



1. Using an coral-orange lip and cheek tint, draw circles over the apples of your cheeks and a rounded triangle on the tip of your nose. The one I used here is [Touch in Sol Technicolor Lip & Cheek Tint With Powder Finish in "Passion Orange."](#)

2. Apply the same lip and cheek tint to your lips.

3. Line your eyes with a metallic gold shade. Try [Nudestix Magnetic Eye Color in "Gilt."](#)

4. Draw a cat-eye and then draw additional flicks that resemble the stitches of a scarecrow. Use a black liquid liner, such as [Kat Von D Five Fearless Years Limited Edition Tattoo Liner in "Trooper."](#)

5. Apply false lashes to make your eyes pop. Try [Make Up For Ever Eyelashes Strip in "21 Floriane."](#)

6. Outline the triangle on your nose and then draw stitch-like dashes around it. Use a pencil liner,

like [e.l.f. Lock on Gel Liner in "Crave it Black."](#)

7. Draw black lines with black pencil liner that extend from your corners of your mouth to the halfway point across your cheeks. Then, draw stitch-like dashes across it.



8. Make your face look more doll-like by drawing small white "shine marks" on your cheeks and nose. Try [NYX Jumbo Eye Pencil in "604 Milk."](#)

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
