Rhamnose, a top ingredient in this formula, is a plant-derived sugar. "Scientific studies show that it can increase cell turnover, collagen production, and also increase elasticity," Dr. Guanche explains.



## **Botanicals The Glow**

The jojoba oil in this pick helps the skin to stay hydrated, while the sea buckthorn oil "brightens and fights skin-aging free radicals because it's an antioxidant," Dr. Guanche notes.



## Birch Juice Hydro

This serum contains chamomile and plantain seed extracts. Dr. Guanche says that chamomile is calming and soothing. The plantain seed extract has germicidal and antibacterial properties.





## Multivitamin Power Firm

The Power Firm contains vitamin A, also known as retinol. "This active ingredient stimulates the production of collagen, regulates epidermal cell proliferation, and softens fine lines and wrinkles," says Dr. Guanche.

The caffeine in this eye cream shrinks loose tissue, promotes circulation, and reduces puffiness, Dr. Guanche says.

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
